REF: November Safety Meeting

1. I/LEADS Maintenance Agreement – Overland Park has invoiced us for the 2010 maintenance agreement for the use of I/LEADS records management system. The city entered into an agreement with OP in regards to the use of the software and after utilizing the formula, Roeland Park's share came to \$2,173.29. This is consistent with the estimate originality given when the agreement was first proposed by OP.
2. VIEVU video camera – The department was given the opportunity to test a VIEVU wearable video camera over the last month. The camera is a one piece unit that is worn on the front of the officer's shirt. I was interested to find out how good were the video and the audio. What we found was that the video and audio was very good and gave us video coverage away from the car. The downside was the camera is knocked off easily and could be lost or broken.

At this point I see the best use of the camera for the community resource officer who is normally away from a car and the detective who could use the camera when making contact with suspects in the field. It could also be used in specific instances when we are making a contact away from a vehicle and video would be beneficial.

The camera activates when the officer moves the lens cover down from in front of the lens and there are no other adjustments necessary. The video is downloaded to a computer using proprietary software that does not allow the video to be altered or erased for 30 days. The cameras come with a 90 day warranty with an option for a one or two year warranty. I suggest that we add a one year warranty to the purchase.

There is currently special pricing on the camera where the first is purchase at full price and the next four purchases are at half price. I propose that the city purchase three VIEVU wearable video cameras utilizing special law enforcement funds. The cost would be \$1,799.89 for three cameras and an additional one year warranty for each camera would be a total of \$420.00. The total request is for \$1,799.89 plus shipping.

3. Community Resource Officer – The community resource officer has been busy with the start of the new school year. She has conducted 12 DARE classes and worked with the school on a number of issues. I will bring MPO Peter's monthly report to the meeting for review.
