

**CITY OF ROELAND PARK, KANSAS
ORDINANCE NO. 820**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATED TO APPOINTIVE OFFICES
OF THE CITY; AMENDING AND REPEALING EXISTING
SECTION 1-313 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF
ROELAND PARK, KANSAS**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROELAND
PARK, KANSAS:**


SECTION 1. Existing Section 1-313 of the Code of the City of Roeland Park, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1-313. CITY PROSECUTOR. There is hereby created the office of city prosecutor. The mayor shall annually appoint a city prosecutor by and with the consent of the city council. Prior to any such appointment, a committee of the governing body appointed by the city council shall interview candidates for the position of city prosecutor and recommend one for appointment by the mayor. The city prosecutor shall be an attorney in good standing and licensed to practice law within the State of Kansas. A person appointed to the office of city prosecutor need not be a resident or qualified elector of the city. The duties of the city prosecutor shall be consistent with the duties set forth in K.S.A. 12-4110 and section 1-312 of this code and shall consist of prosecuting cases in the municipal court and performing such other duties as assigned to him or her by the city attorney. With the exception of the duties of assisting, conjunctively in the prosecution of matters in the municipal court, the city prosecutor's duties shall not in any way diminish the general duties of the city attorney as set forth in section 1-312.


SECTION 2. Existing Section 1-313 of the Code of the City of Roeland Park, Kansas, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. The Ordinance shall take effect upon its publication in the official City newspaper.
