


Leaf Removal Program Information

Vacuum Removal at the Curb

- Rake leaves in long piles behind the curb. Leaves must be kept out of the street. **Leaves in the street will not be collected and must be removed by the resident.**
- Leaves should be pushed to the front side of the sidewalk nearest the street-allowing pedestrians to use the other side of the sidewalk
- Place leaves behind curb the Sunday prior to your scheduled pickup.
- Keep leaf piles free of limbs and litter. Our ability to use the vacuum and compost the leaves is dependent on a **leaf only** collection stream.
- Keep leaves away from obstacles- collection carts, mailboxes, cars and utility poles.
- Do not park your vehicle in front of leaves during collection hours of M-F 7am-5pm and Sat 7:30am-3:30pm.



Ideal Placement of Leaves

Leaf Placement Guide

Sidewalk with grass divider:
Place between sidewalk and street



Sidewalk next to street:
Place on sidewalk-push towards street to allow use of sidewalk



No sidewalk:
No more than 8 ft from street, behind the back of the curb



Lawn Bag/Container Pickup

- Available year-round
- The City's waste hauler GFL will continue to offer leaf pickup via paper yard bags and containers with a "yard waste" label. Stickers are available free of charge at City Hall.
- Place leaves in bags and/or properly labeled containers and place by the curb on your regular trash collection day.
- Ensure yard waste is free from trash or debris
- Bags must be biodegradable—no plastic bags allowed.
- Limbs should be in bundles secured with twine or string not exceeding 4 feet long or 18 inches in diameter. Bundles should not weigh more than 50 pounds.
